

Janet Mullany is an award-winning, multi-published author who writes books set mainly in Regency England. Her first book, *Dedication* (2005) won the New Jersey Romance Writers 2006 Golden Leaf Contest. *The Rules of Gentility*, a funny, chicklit style Regency, won the 2008 HOLT Award (Virginia Romance Writers) for Best Romantic Comedy. She's contracted to Little Black Dress Books, UK, for three more funny Regencies, the first of which, *A Most Lamentable Comedy*, will be released in July, 2009. In 2010, she makes her paranormal debut with a book about Jane Austen joining vampires to fight a French invasion (HarperCollins), and a novella in an anthology based on paranormal re-tellings of Austen's novels (Harlequin).
